★ Addiction Treatment Services Provider – Regular

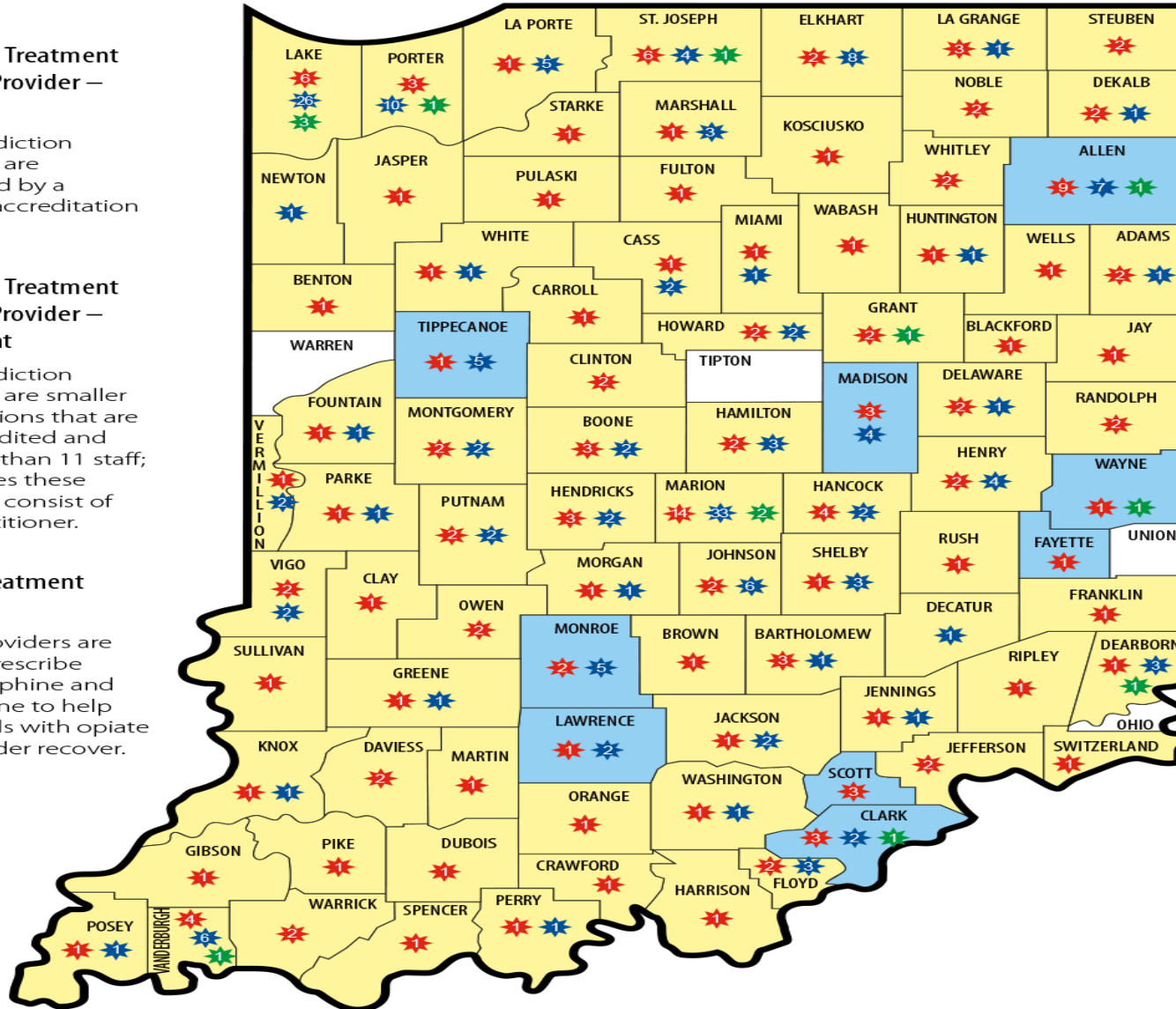
These addiction providers are accredited by a national accreditation entity.

★ Addiction Treatment Services Provider – Outpatient

These addiction providers are smaller organizations that are not accredited and have less than 11 staff; sometimes these providers consist of one practitioner.

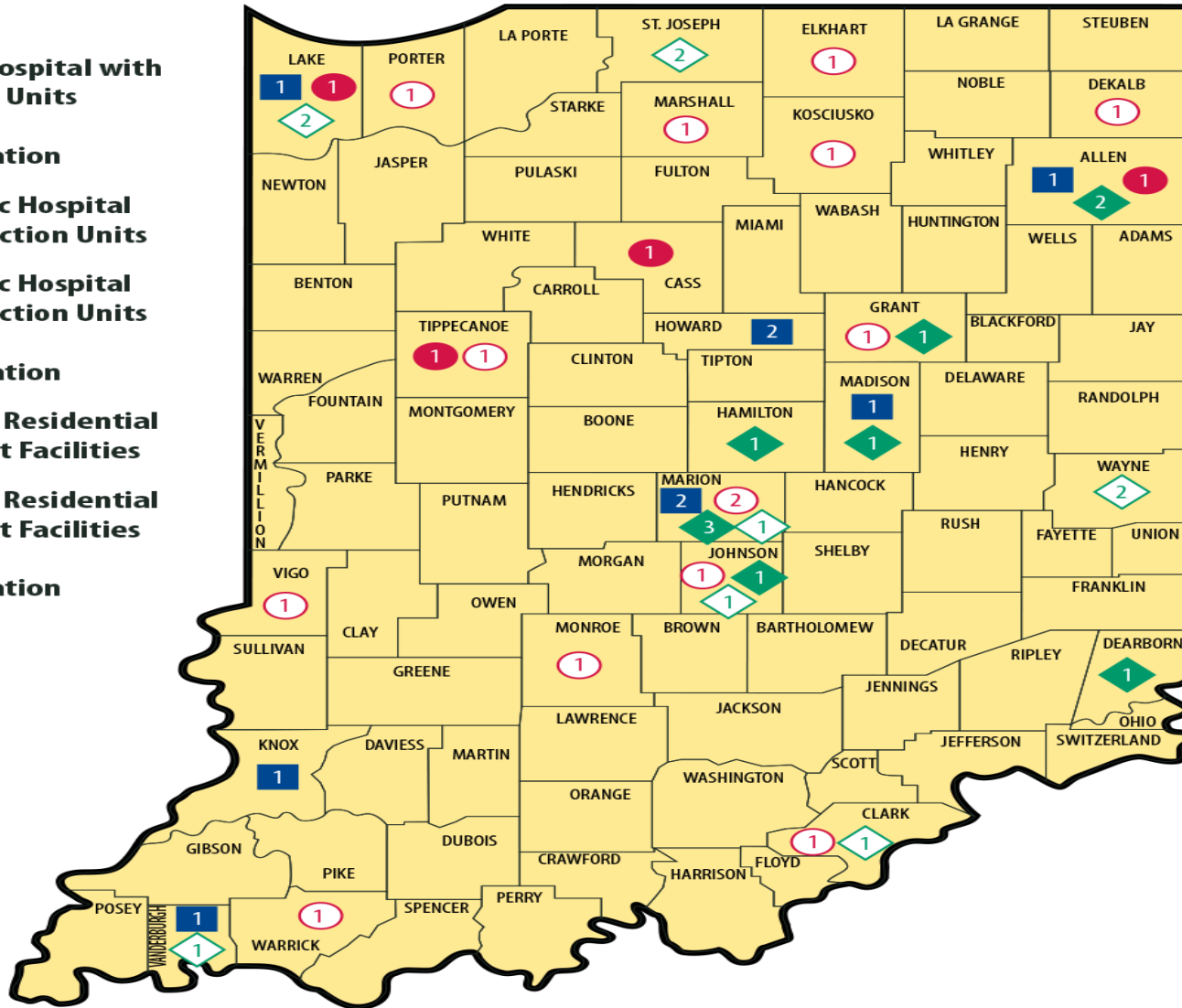
★ Opioid Treatment Programs

These providers are able to prescribe Buprenorphine and Methadone to help individuals with opiate use disorder recover.
